



CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Holiday Themed Costume Class: Open to all ages. Can be mounted or unmounted.

- Dress up your horse or your dog! May be divided by age depending on number of entries. Any official holiday goes. The judge may ask questions about your costume.

Walk Division: Open to riders aged 12 years and younger who are not able to trot unassisted. Riders may not cross enter any other division. Riders are welcome to enter the Holiday Costume Contest.

- Walk: Riders will be required to walk and steer on their own. May be asked to two-point. Could also be asked to halt and back. A helper may walk alongside the horse if necessary.
- Walk Course: Riders will be required to follow a simple course including poles and cones. A helper may walk alongside the horse if necessary.

Walk/Trot Obstacle Course: Open to all. Not part of the W/T games division. May be split by age depending on number of entries. Will be timed.

- Riders will be required to follow a course at the walk and trot. The course may include poles, cones, mailbox, and an optional bridge.
- Riders will be penalized for cantering on course.

Simon Says: Open to all ages. Not part of the W/T games division.

- Commands will be called out by one person, "Simon". Riders are to follow Simon's instructions, and only follow through with the command if "Simon Says" is included. For example, if Simon says, "Simon Says trot on the wrong diagonal", all riders need to post the trot on the wrong diagonal. But if Simon says, "Trot on the wrong diagonal", any riders that follow this command will be eliminated. The last rider left is the winner of the class.

RIDERS MAY CHOOSE TO ENTER EITHER THE W/T OR THE W/T/C GAMES CLASSES REGARDLESS OF THEIR OTHER CLASSES/DIVISIONS. THEY MAY NOT DO BOTH.

Egg & Spoon: Open to all ages. May be ridden with a saddle or bareback.

- Walk/Trot: Riders will ride on the rail in both directions at the walk and trot while holding an egg in a spoon with one hand. Riders may not touch the egg. If the egg is dropped, they must halt in the center of the arena. The last rider to have their egg in their spoon is the winner. May be asked for posting trot, sitting trot, two-point, halt, and back.
- Walk/Trot/Canter: Riders will walk and trot on the rail in both directions at the walk, trot, and canter while holding an egg in a spoon with one hand. Riders may not touch the egg. If the egg is dropped, they must halt in the center of the arena. The last rider to have their egg in their spoon is the winner. May be asked for posting trot, sitting trot, two-point, halt, and back.

Sit A Buck: Open to all ages. Riders to each supply a \$1 bill. Winner keeps all the dollars.

- Walk/Trot: Riders are mounted bareback without a bareback pad and will be required to walk and trot on the rail in both directions. A one-dollar bill is to be placed under their thigh and may not be touched by the rider. If the dollar drops, the rider must halt in the center of the arena. The last rider to have the dollar still in place is the winner and wins all of the dollars in the class. May be asked for posting trot, sitting trot, two-point, circles, halt, and back.
- Walk/Trot/Canter: Riders are mounted bareback without a bareback pad and will be required to walk, trot, and canter on the rail in both directions. A one-dollar bill is to be placed under their thigh and may not be touched by the rider during the class. If the dollar drops, the rider must halt in the center of the arena. The last rider to have the dollar still in place is the winner and wins all of the dollars in the class. May be asked for posting trot, sitting trot, two-point, circles, halt, and back.

Bareback Equitation: Open to all ages.

- Walk/Trot: May not cross into any W/T/C classes. Riders to be mounted bareback without a bareback pad and will be required to walk and trot in both directions. May be asked for sitting trot, posting trot, two-point, halt, and back.
- Walk/Trot/Canter: Open to all. May not cross into any W/T classes. Riders to be mounted bareback without a bareback pad and will be required to walk, trot, and canter in both directions. May be asked for sitting trot, posting trot, two-point, halt, and back.

Open W/T Beginner Division: Open to riders of all ages who are not showing above cross rails. Riders may not cross enter any other division. Riders may participate in the Holiday Costume class and walk/trot games classes.

- Walk/Trot HUS: Riders will be required to walk and trot on the rail in both directions.
- Walk/Trot Equitation: Riders will be required to walk and trot on the rail in both directions. May be asked for sitting trot or two-point. May also be asked to halt and back.
- Walk/Trot Pleasure: Riders will be required to walk and trot on the rail in both directions. May be asked to halt and back.
- Walk/Trot Poles: Riders will be required to trot a simple pole course. Riders will be penalized for cantering on course.
- Walk/Trot Cross Rails: Riders will be required to trot a simple cross rail course. Riders will be penalized for cantering on course.

Green W/T Beginner Division: Open to riders of all ages. Designed with the green and young horse in mind. Does not effect eligibility for other classes.

- Walk/Trot HUS: Riders will be required to walk and trot on the rail in both directions.
- Walk/Trot Equitation: Riders will be required to walk and trot on the rail in both directions. May be asked for sitting trot or two-point. May also be asked to halt and back.
- Walk/Trot/Canter HUS: Riders will be required to walk and trot on the rail in both directions in a group. Riders will be asked to canter one at a time on the rail. May be asked to halt and back.

- Walk/Trot/Canter Equitation: Riders will be required to walk and trot on the rail in both directions in a group. Riders will be asked to canter one at a time on the rail.
- Walk/Trot Poles: Riders will be required to complete a simple pole course. Riders will not be penalized for cantering on course and may choose to complete the course at the canter.
- Walk/Trot Cross Rails: Riders will be required to complete a simple cross rail course. Riders will not be penalized for cantering on course and may choose to complete the course at the canter.

17 & Under W/T/C Division: Open to riders 17 years and younger who are not showing above cross rails. Riders may not cross enter any higher division. Riders may enter W/T/C games classes.

- Walk/Trot/Canter HUS: Riders will be required to walk, trot, and canter on the rail in both directions.
- Walk/Trot/Canter Equitation: Riders will be required to walk and trot on the rail in both directions. May be asked to sit trot, halt, or back.
- Walk/Trot/Canter Cross Rails: Riders will be required to canter a cross rail course on the correct lead. Will not be penalized for trotting on course.

18 & Over W/T/C Division: Open to riders 18 years and older who are not showing above cross rails. Riders may not cross enter any other division. Riders may enter W/T/C games classes.

- Walk/Trot/Canter HUS: Riders will be required to walk, trot, and canter on the rail in both directions.
- Walk/Trot/Canter Equitation: Riders will be required to walk and trot on the rail in both directions. May be asked to sit trot, halt, or back.
- Walk/Trot/Canter Cross Rails: Riders will be required to canter a cross rail course on the correct lead. Will not be penalized for trotting on course.

Jumpers 18”: Open to riders of all ages who are not competing at 2’ or higher. May not cross enter in 2’3 or higher classes. Will be timed.

- Jumps set to a maximum of 18” tall. Will not include oxers. Will include rollbacks.

Jumpers 2’: Open to riders of all ages. Will be timed.

- Jumps set to a maximum of 2’ tall. Will include oxers and rollbacks.

Jumpers 2’3: Open to riders of all ages. Will be timed.

- Jumps set to a maximum of 2’3 tall. Will include oxers and rollbacks.

Jumpers Height of Choice: Open to riders of all ages. Class fee per round. Will be timed.

- Riders may choose their course height. All riders in this class will be judged together unless entries permit splitting the class by height.

Hunter 18”: Open to all horses and riders. May not cross enter in 2’3 or higher classes.

- Flat: Riders will be required to walk, trot, and canter in both directions.
- Over fences: Riders will be required to canter the course. Riders will not be penalized for trot changes.

Equitation 18”: Open to all horses and riders. May not cross enter in 2’3 or higher classes.

- Flat: Riders will be required to walk, trot, and canter in both directions. Riders may be asked for sitting trot or two-point.
- Over fences: Riders will be required to canter the course. Riders will not be penalized for trot changes.

Hunter 2’: Open to riders of all ages.

- Flat: Riders will be required to walk, trot, and canter in both directions. May be asked to halt and back.
- Over fences: Riders will be required to canter the course. Riders will not be penalized for simple changes through the trot.

Equitation 2’: Open to riders of all ages.

- Flat: Riders will be required to walk, trot, and canter in both directions. Riders may be asked for sitting trot and two-point and may also be asked to halt and back.
- Over fences: Riders will be required to canter a course. Riders will not be penalized for simple changes through the trot.

Hunter/Equitation Height of Choice: Open to riders of all ages. Class fee per round.

- Riders may choose their course height. All riders in this class will be judged together. May be split by height if entries permit.
